**ORDINANCE NO. 806**

**AN ORDINANCE ATTESTING TO AN INCREASE IN TAX REVENUES  
FOR BUDGET YEAR 2008 FOR THE CITY OF ROELAND PARK, KANSAS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Roeland Park must continue to provide services to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of this community;

**WHEREAS**, the cost of providing essential services to the citizens of this City continues to increase;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROELAND PARK, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** In accordance with the Kansas Budget Law, the City of Roeland Park has conducted a public hearing and has published the proposed budget necessary to fund City services from January 1, 2008 until December 31, 2008.

**SECTION 2.** After careful public deliberations, the governing body has determined that in order to maintain the public services which are essential for the citizens of this City, it will be necessary to budget property tax revenues in an amount which exceeds the 2007 budget.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its publication in the official City newspaper.
