

**CITY OF ROELAND PARK, KANSAS
ORDINANCE NO. 815**

**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO OVERHANGING TREES AND SHRUBS AS
NUISANCES; AMENDING AND REPEALING EXISTING SECTION 8-402 OF
THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ROELAND PARK, KANSAS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROELAND
PARK, KANSAS:**

SECTION 1. Existing Section 8-402 of the Code of the City of Roeland Park, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8-402. OVERHANGING TREES AND SHRUBS. All trees and hedges on any private property or in the parking areas abutting any public sidewalk or street, the branches of which are higher than one foot or lower than eight feet above the surface of such sidewalk or lower than sixteen feet above the traveled portion of such street which obstructs the vision of any person, pedestrian or driver of a vehicle using the public streets or sidewalks, of persons or vehicles approaching from other directions on the same or other public streets or sidewalks, or which poses a hazard to vehicles using the public streets, shall be a nuisance subject to the provisions of this chapter.


SECTION 2. Existing Section 8-402 of the Code of the City of Roeland Park, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
