

## **Rules, Wavier, Hours, and Membership Guidelines**

### **Pool Rules:**

1. Obey instruction of lifeguards and management.
  2. Swimming is allowed only when a lifeguard is on duty.
  3. Horseplay such as running, splashing, shoving, and dunking is not allowed.
  4. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 16.
  5. Diving is allowed on diving boards only. No diving off the slide of the pool.
  6. No coolers, glass containers, or smoking is allowed in the pool.
  7. Open sores and discharging bodily fluids are not allowed.
  8. Profanity, improper behavior, and intoxication are not allowed.
- Violators will be removed immediately from the facility.**
9. Any child younger than 36 months (3 years) must wear a swim diaper.
  10. Follow the schedule for different activities (such as lap swim, open swim, diving, and swim meets)

### **Diving:**

1. Only one person at a time on the boards
2. Wait to climb up the ladder until the person in front of you has exited the pool.
3. Only one bounce on the diving boards.
4. Swim to the ladder closest to you and exit the pool immediately.
5. You must be able to swim unassisted to the side of the pool. Parents are not allowed to help or catch their children.
6. No goggles or personal floatation devices allowed.

### **Baby Pool Rules:**

1. You must be 6 years or younger and under 48" tall to enter the baby pool.
2. Use the sprayers after playing in the sand.
3. Children must go feet first on their back down the slide.
4. No personal floatation devices are allowed on the slide.
5. Children must be accompanied by an adult 16 years or older.
6. Diaper changing is NOT allowed on the pool deck and is allowed only in areas where diaper changing stations are available (restrooms).

### **Vortex Pool Rules:**

1. One person per tube.
2. You must use the pool's tubes to use the vortex pool.
3. Listen to lifeguard to know when to enter and exit the pool.
4. Children too young to ride in a tube alone may ride with an adult.
5. Do not flip tubes over while using the pool to avoid injury.

### **Slides:**

1. You must be over 48" tall to go down the slides.
2. Children must be able to swim unassisted to the side of the pool.
3. No goggles, personal floatation devices, toys, or glasses may be taken down the slide.
4. One person at a time down the top slide. One or two at a time down the group slide. Holding hands, sitting on laps, etc. is not allowed.

### **Special Notice:**

1. Pool patrons- if you, your children, or guests have experienced diarrhea in the last month, **DO NOT ENTER THE WATER.**
2. Do not drink the pool water.

3. If a fecal accident occurs in the pool, all guests will be cleared out of the pool. Depending on the type of accident, the pool may be closed for the remainder of the day.

**Other Pool Rules:**

1. There is absolutely NO SMOKING inside of the facility. **Violators will be removed from the facility.**
2. Everyone who swims in this facility must wear an actual swim suit. You may wear a t-shirt over your suit for sun protection. Females must have on a lycra or spandex type of suit, no bras or underwear. Males must wear mesh shorts or swim shorts, no cut-offs, khakis, jean shorts, cotton shorts, etc. You will be asked to change or leave if you are not wearing appropriate swimming attire. RPAC staff reserves the right to designate what is appropriate swim attire and what is not.
3. Profanity will not be tolerated in this facility. Failure to comply with this rule will result in expulsion from the facility and possible termination of your membership.
4. There is absolutely no food, alcohol, or drinks other than water allowed in the pool. RPAC reserves the right to check bags for items not allowed in the facility. Special circumstances will be considered by management if you or a family member is diabetic, suffering from a metabolic disorder, if you have a newborn baby.
5. Children must be accompanied by an adult 16 years of age or older at all times while in the facility. Parents MUST be with in arms reach of children who cannot swim. Failure to do so will result in expulsion from the facility. This rule is here for the safety of you, your family, and guests. We do not want anyone to get hurt while enjoying their swim.
6. NO REFUNDS will be given if you choose not to follow the rules and end up getting suspended from the facility for the summer.

**Wavier:**

“The undersigned states that he/she understands that Johnson County Park and Recreation District is not and shall not be responsible for or liable for any illness, or injury to person or damage to property resulting from the program in which the undersigned is enrolling or being enrolled or from his/her participating in said program, and the participant and the undersigned, if the participant is a minor or under legal disability, hereby forever releases and holds harmless the said Johnson County Park and Recreation District, its employees, agents and representatives from any and all claims of any kind that the participant, or the undersigned or their respective heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns may have or claim to undersigned and participant authorize Johnson County Park and Recreation District to use at its discretion any photograph(s) (black/white or color) taken of the participant while participating in the program and waive any and all claims that the participant and undersigned or their heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns may have or claim to have resulting from such photograph(s) or reproductions thereof.”

**Inclement Weather Policy:**

In the event of bad weather, RPAC reserves the right to close down the facility for the safety of our patrons and staff. During lightening, patrons and staff must stay clear of the water and pool deck for 30 minutes after the last lightening strike. If there is a tornado or the sirens are sounding, all patrons and staff must move calmly and swiftly to safety in the community center's boiler room. If the temperature falls below 70 degrees, RPAC reserves the right to close the pool until said temperature has risen above 70 degrees.

**Additional Note:**

These rules have been put in place for the safety of the guests and staff who use the pool. We all want to have a fun and safe summer. JCPRD and the City of Roeland Park have made significant changes to the facility this season in hopes to make it a safe and fun environment for all of our patrons and participants.
