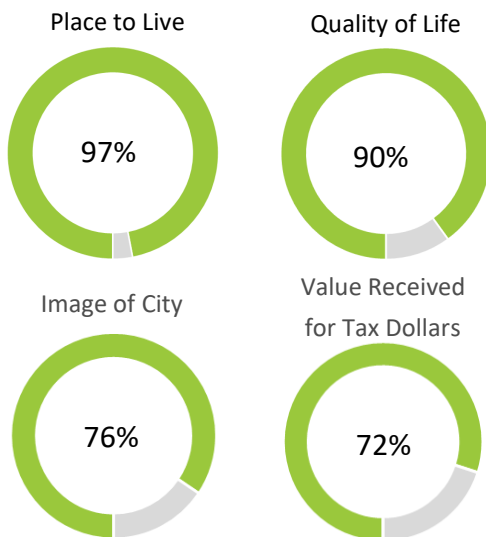


Summary of Key Findings—Citizen's Satisfaction Survey 2019

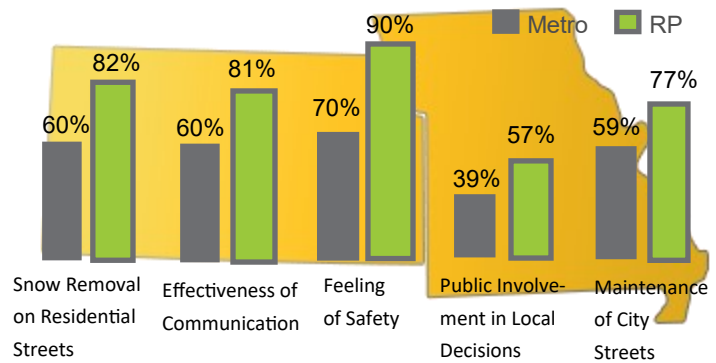
How does RP Rank?

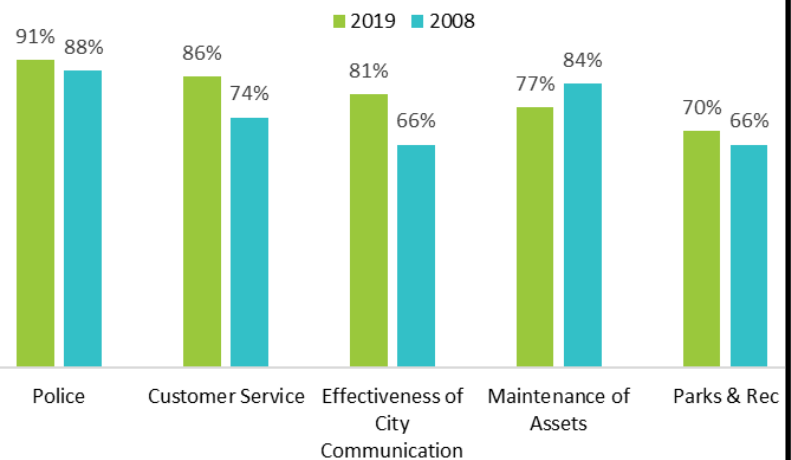
Where should we Focus?

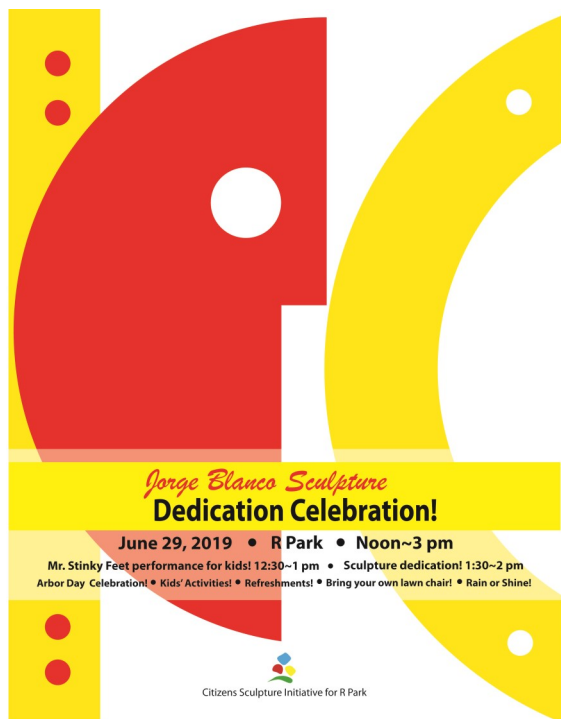
These service areas should receive the most focus in the next two years. Percentage of respondents that selected item as one of their top 3 choices

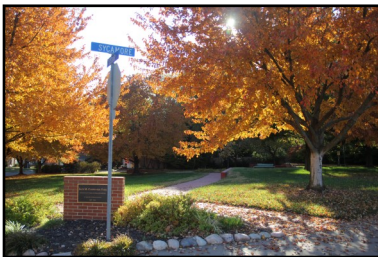
