Provisions and Guidelines

- ◆ All options of the Memorial Tree Program will be subject to the provisions and guidelines set forth by the City of Roeland Park to better serve the community and for the success and enhancement of this program and the City's parks.
- ◆ Memorial Trees may be dedicated on existing trees on City owned property which are not currently dedicated, subject to approval by the City. (List of locations available on application).
- ◆ All trees selected will be of 1.5 to 1.75 inch caliper for single stem plants, or 5 to 8ft typical height for multi stem or evergreen plants; tree species and size are subject to grower availability and may vary each season. The City of Roeland Park Public Works and maintenance staff will provide all care necessary for the tree to the standards set for all park plantings.
- ◆ **Wording on plaques** - The donor may choose either of the following wordings on the plaque, "In Memory of" or "In Honor of"; followed by the name of the individual. **To standardize markers the inscription on marker will be limited due to size.**
- ◆ The City of Roeland Park will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur to the tree or plaque and all warranties shall come from the place of purchase. **If possible, the City will endeavor to repair or replace damage to trees and markers as funding allows.**
- ◆ All original trees and replacement trees will be installed within the next appropriate planting season after purchase. **Planting seasons are late Fall and early Spring and are subject to weather considerations.**

Memorial Tree Program Options

The Roeland Park Memorial Tree Program offers different options to choose from to provide you with the memorial planting that best allows you to honor the memory of your loved one.

Option 1— New Tree Planting with Memorial Plaque :

For a sum of \$680.00, a new tree will be planted in memory of your loved one. A bronze marker *(4" x 6") will be placed at the base of the tree.

Option 2— New Tree Planting:

For a sum of \$405.00, a new tree will be planted in memory of your loved one without a memorial plaque.

Option 3— Adopt an existing Tree with Memorial Plaque:

For a sum of \$275.00, a *(4" x 6") bronze marker will be placed at the base of an existing tree to be memorialized in honor of your loved one.

Option 4: - Adopt an existing Tree:

For a sum of \$50.00, a dedication of an existing tree to be memorialized in honor of your loved one
