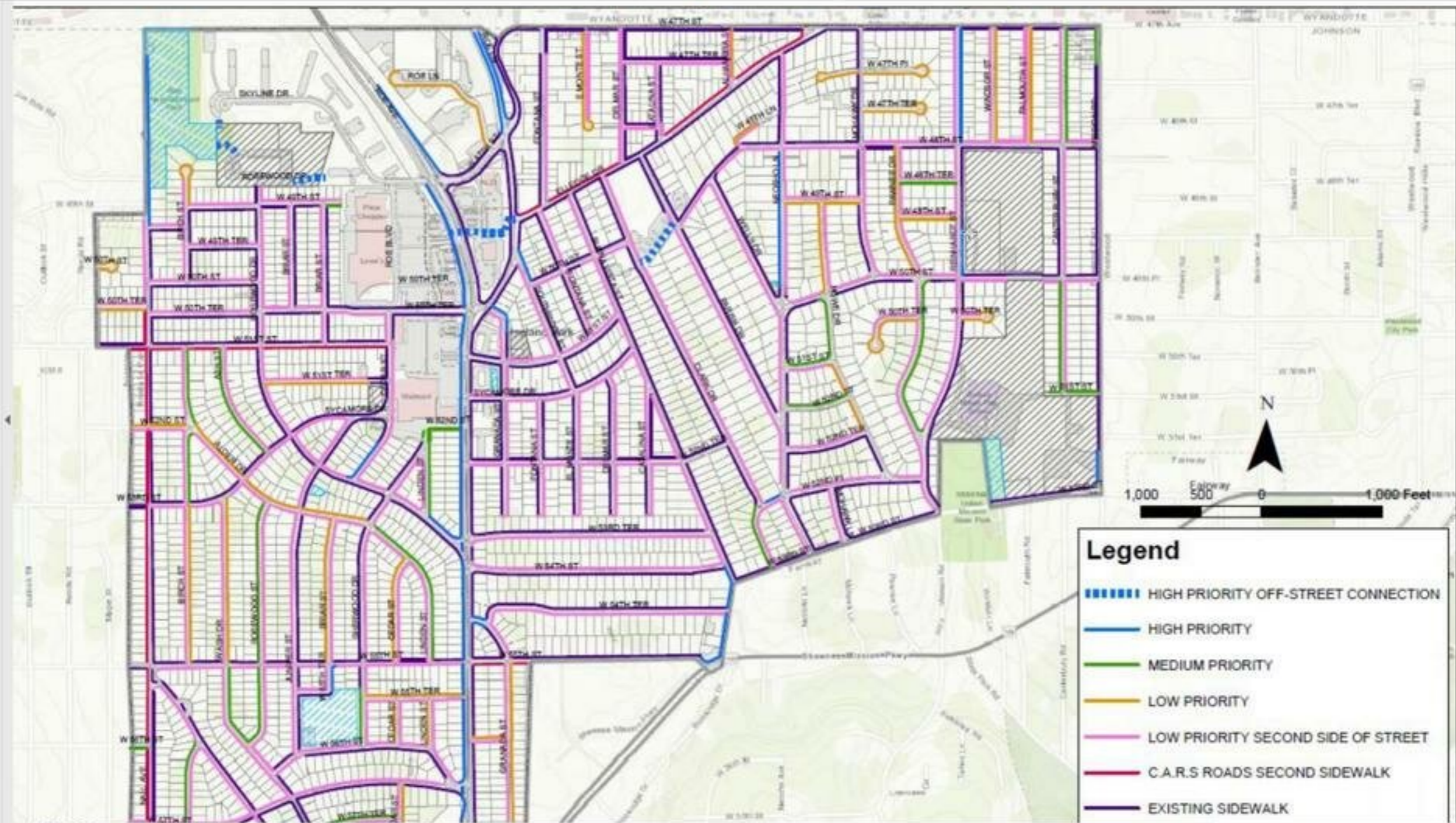


## WHY?? NEED / PURPOSE?

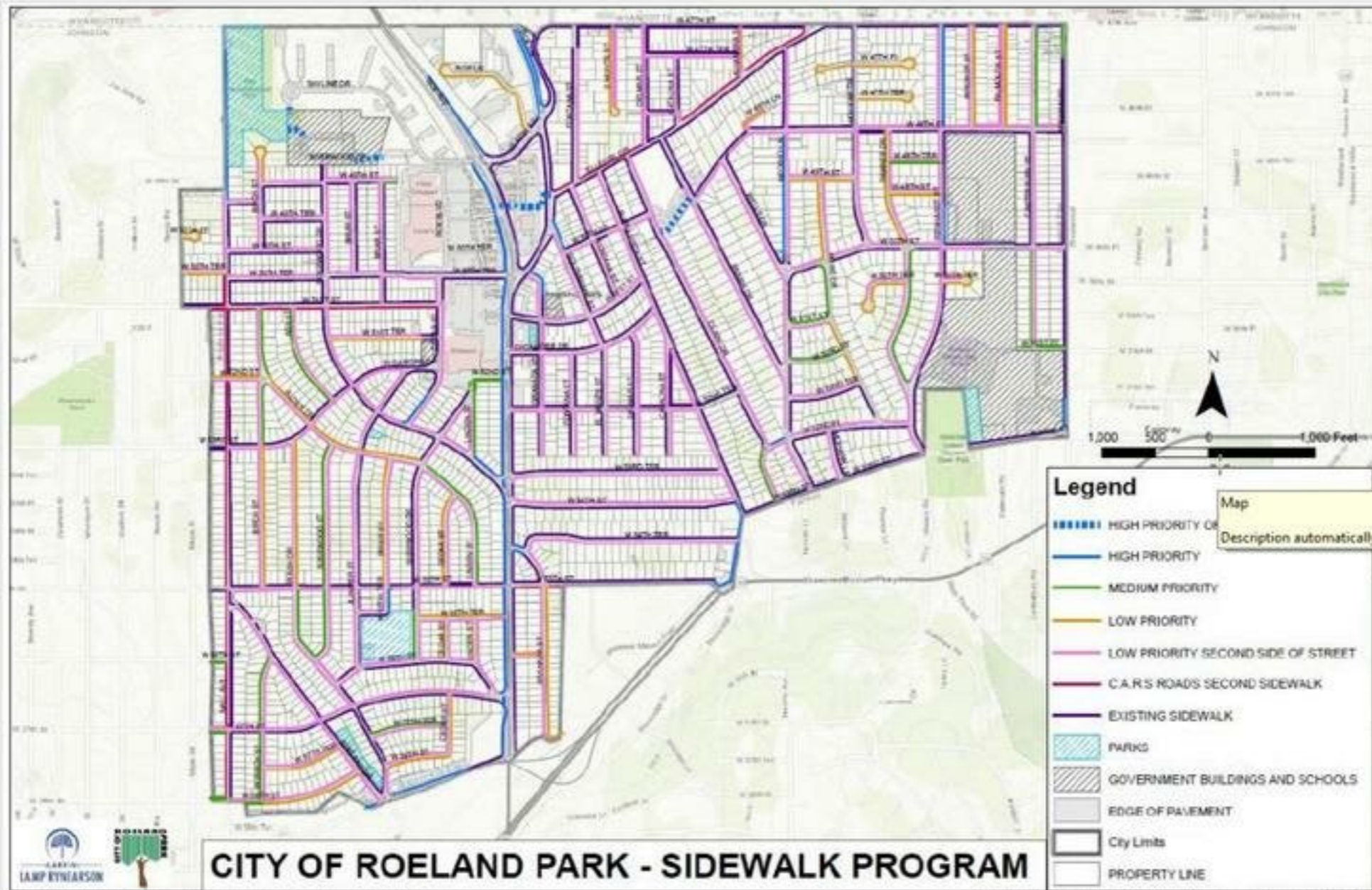
---

The City replaces or installs new sidewalk to ADA standards on an annual basis, prioritizing the construction where there are gaps in connectivity and higher demand for sidewalks. Extending a sidewalk along Reinhardt Drive between W 48<sup>th</sup> Street and W 47<sup>th</sup> Street will provide a safe route for pedestrians in the neighborhood.

# SIDEWALK LOCATION CONSIDERATIONS

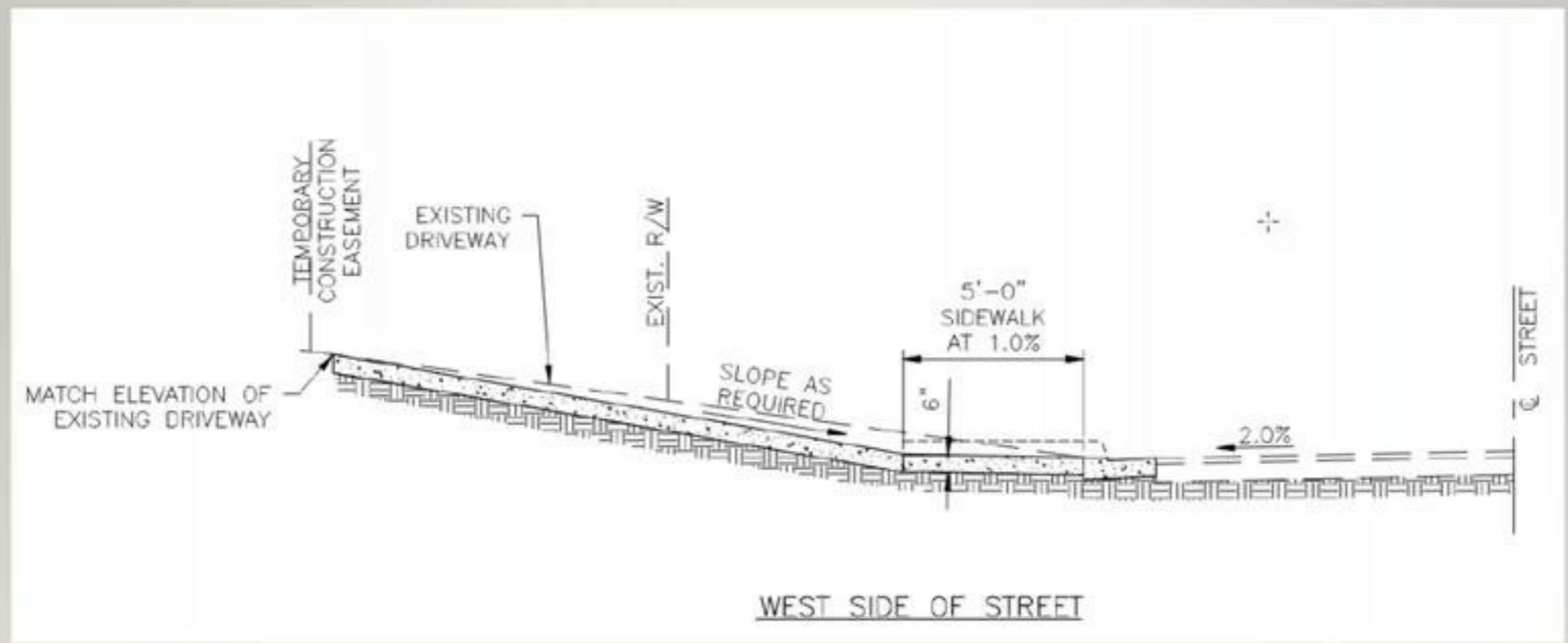

## SIDEWALK ON WEST SIDE

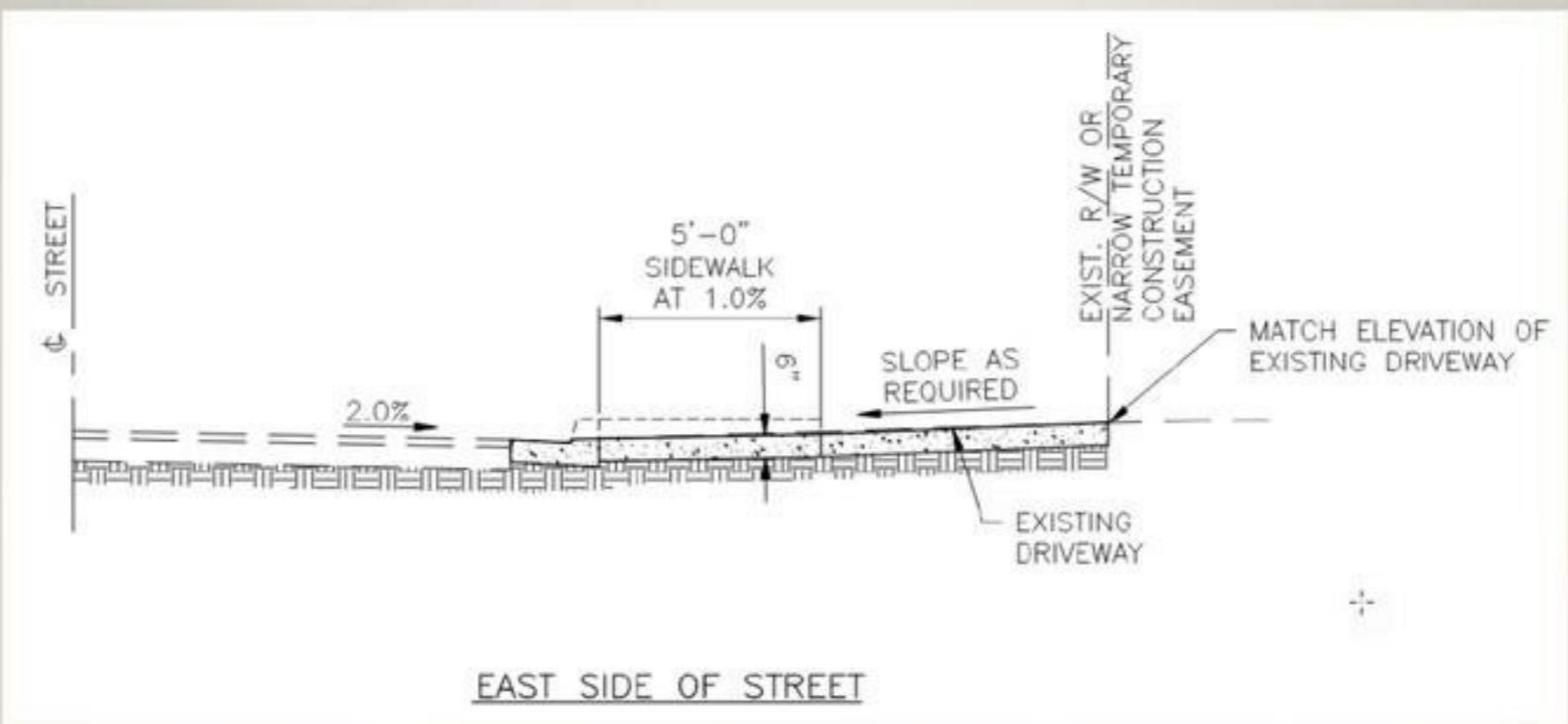
- Wider temporary construction easements are required
- Some utility relocation (power poles)
- Longer driveway replacements, yard grading, and sidewalk curb needed
- More expensive side

## SIDEWALK ON EAST SIDE

- 8 trees would need to be removed
- More utility relocations (communication, utility poles, fire hydrant and a power pole)
- Minimal impacts to existing yards and driveways
- Less expensive side
