A. Modifications to the Agenda – NONE

B. Meeting minutes from 7/5/23 were approved.

C. Open Action Items – There was no discussion on getting a trash can near the ALDI stairs, and the Damsel lighting is still in distress.

D. New Business

1. Gateway sculpture – Nothing new. There aren't any pictures or images of progress yet.

2. Moving the sculptures currently at Public Works – Nothing new. They are very busy with tree debris and getting ready to move to new facility.

3. Expenses – We will have a new regularly occurring agenda item to approve expenses. Marek will send expenses to the committee ahead of the meeting and we will share expense info with Jonna as they occur.

4. Expenses for Paul Benson's restoration of Lines of Corona were reviewed and approved.

5. Paul Benson will meet with committee members as available in the near future to increase understanding, restoration and maintenance methods for outdoor sculptures. Marek and Mary will ask Parks and Trees if they can attend the sculpture session too. Kelley and Jan reminded the committee that Public Works and Parks will be doing the work too.

6. Signs for trees and sculptures – Laura is no longer with Parks and Trees, but Sarah is and Mary has an email with them that describes current status of the signs. We are still including QR codes however it is not decided where they will direct the public. Mary and Marek hope to meet with Parks at their meeting next Wednesday to discuss the signs for the artists.

7. Granada Park trash bins – Ideas are still being generated to paint all 5 cans. Can we use art from the skaters that use the park? Also, the Girl Scouts are being considered. This

would be a 2024 budget item. Jonna will take the lead and call Mieke and the Girl Scouts about their possible involvement.

8. Speed Limit 34 artwork at R Park – There is concern from the artist about the sign needing two posts and possibly being higher. Mary and Marek will ask Parks if they can attend their next meeting to discuss the Speed Limit 34 artwork.

9. 2024 project list – The committee identified four possible projects –

- a. AARP Grant
- b. Professionally created brochure of Roeland Park public art
- c. Mural or light show on City Hall wall outdoors
- d. New art piece – not defined at this time

E. Gallery Update – The next reception is August 11 at 5PM. Buena Vista Studio group will be the exhibitors for September/October.
